Dreyfuss Plaza is a large, new shaded pedestrian plaza on the Florham Park campus of Fairleigh Dickinson University. This 13,500 square foot space anchors and connects two new academic buildings, the state-of-the-art Ferguson Recreation Center and the Dreyfuss Theater. It provides a comfortable and attractive place for students to congregate in groups or to find a quiet resting place in between classes. Characterized by large old shade trees, gracious new paths, beautiful paving, simple and elegant plantings, plenty of seating on the curving seat wall and period benches, and well-placed decorative light fixtures, the radiating design incorporates the architecture of the peripherally-located Recreation Center into the Olmstedian character of the rest of the campus.
