The "Garden in Tewksbury" has long views of the existing wetlands and preserved open space which border the property. Mature native dogwoods are scattered throughout the site and provide a unique character and framework for woodland plants. We worked with our clients to develop a scope of work which maintained these existing features and added: a koi pond framed by a pergola, patios, walls and walks, and extensive improvements to an existing pool.

When planning the koi pond, our office researched worked closely with our contractors to ensure the creation of a healthy, sustainable habitat for fish and aquatic plants alike. Major plantings around the pergola, patio and pond were designed and include an extensive variety of flowering shrubs and perennials.

The pool renovations included the construction of native fieldstone retaining walls and a bluestone patio. The patio was reduced in size to reduce impervious coverage and to allow a soft lawn edge around most of the pool. A sunny perennial border was redesigned to wrap the northern edge of the pool patio and a deer fence was installed to protect the plantings.

Other garden design included: a native woodland restoration, a moss and Hosta garden, a native shrub border, a shady perennial garden and a culinary herb garden.
