

A Private Residence

This unique site sits within the New Jersey Highlands and combines steep, rocky terrain, forested woodland and spectacular views of surrounding lakes and ridges. A stone house sits at the high point of the property and was originally used as a hunting retreat. Davies Associates, Landscape Architects used a combination of native stone from the site and bluestone to create new steps, walls and patios around the house for our client. We also used the native stone to create tall piers to support a deck which extends off the house and has extensive views to the west. Special attention was given to providing a diverse native plant palette around the house and within a large meadow beyond.
